I wondered if you can tell me whether Churchdown Parish know of any 7 v 7 pitches available, or that could be available which we could hire. we would require at least x1 7 v 7 pitch as we have x2 age groups. The children using the space are in school year 4 & 5, and we would require use from September to late March/ April for league fixtures on Saturday mornings, and possibly a weekday evening throughout the summer months for training. We would seek a winter venue with flood lights for training during the colder months. If they agree to John Daniels, we would be happy to work around the cricket team during the Summer months.
