### Community Speed Watch – Cllr Pierre Weinzweig

Both groups remain active and continue to supply the Police with the products of those sessions. As we come to Winter weather, the frequency will drop.

It was quite notable that on the Churchdown and Innsworth Facebook page, that the letters generated at our St John's session on of 7<sup>th</sup> September how people don't look at the speed signs. They are the standard size at both ends, but the unacceptably small size along the road. A great many responses pointed out that it's been that speed for 6 years.

We looked at Albemarle on the 14<sup>th</sup> (14:00) and saw that parking made vehicles weave, therefore acting as a traffic calming. We moved to Parton/Station Road and recorded speeds of 52mph, included in the 19% of traffic exceeding 35mph. There were some outrageous manoeuvres that I advised the Police on, as road safety issues. 360 turns on the mini roundabout outside the Parish Offices.

Earlier in the month. The Police attended that junction and recorded 19 people who were being progressed to prosecution.

I have asked Ben for a suggestion of how we can progress towards having road speeds painted on the surface along with better signage. I'll update one when I have one.
