

Report on Activity at GAPTC

The AGM of the GAPTC was held at Highnam Community Centre on 23rd July 2022 and was well attended.

The guest speaker was Ed Gemmell from Hazlemere Parish Council who gave an address on Climate Change. He was well versed in the subject and spoke for about 20 minutes and then took some questions.

Essential standard business was conducted. Officers were elected followed by a list of actions taken with respect to last year's resolutions.

This was followed by the signing off of the accounts.

Discussion then took place on the propositions registered by various Parish Councils.

Painswick Parish Council submitted a proposition concerning holiday lets which concerned the growth of this sector and its ramifications.

A technical proposition from Rodborough Parish Council concerning the barring of a councillor failed to gain support and was defeated.

Chipping Campden submitted a proposal concerning the selection of the Housing Association on new developments. The crux being that the Parish Councils has no input to the choice.

A proposal about Parish Councils working in partnerships was not proceeded with as nobody from Brockworth P C was present to propose.

The meeting ended with presentations from the sponsors namely, HAGS (an outdoor equipment provider), Edge IT (a software company) and the Council Website Template which was presented by Cllr Adrian Abbs.
